The Role

The primary purpose of the role is to be involved in and support all aspects of the finance function, particularly the FP&A team.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Prepare the quarterly Lloyd's forecast (QMA) including completion of the associated Lloyd's reporting
- Assist with the Group strategic planning and business planning processes including incorporating the Lloyd's SBF data into the GAAP forecast for the syndicates and as well as preparing the forecast for the entire LSL group of companies
- Prepare analysis of actual results as compared to the SBF, business plan and reforecasts for reporting to management and the Board
- Develop and maintain control environment within Board modelling tools and ensure adequate reconciliations are in place between systems to ensure data consistency and integrity
- Assist with ad hoc projects, analyses or decision support as required
