1. Purpose

The successful candidate will be reporting to the Head of Reserving and will be part of an established and training-focussed actuarial team. The successful candidate will have responsibility for portfolio management activities for LSL Syndicates 2010 and 3010.

Study support will be provided to a successful candidate to complete the actuarial exams. We also welcome applications from candidates who have chosen not to sit the actuarial exams.

- Analysing policy and claims data to identify portfolio management trends, findings or recommendations for escalation, to support profitable growth
- Production of management information such as dashboards and slide decks
- Development of portfolio management function, including building of models and enhanced automation
- Developing risk scoring, portfolio pricing and algorithmic trading capabilities
- Regular interaction with various stakeholders including reserving team, pricing team, underwriters and data team
- Input into Actuarial Function Report – Underwriting Opinion
